

TENTATIVE TIMELINE

FOR BOUNDARY CONSIDERATIONS

- September 2014** Discuss timeline with Demographer and make any necessary adjustments
- September 2014** Meet with E&F Committee to discuss plan for the next eighteen to twenty months and gather feedback
- September 2014** Train staff members on how to use boundary software from the Omega Group
- September 2014** Submit potential scenarios to demographer so they can begin to build solutions.
- October 2014** Present revised guidelines to the Board and inform principals of the guidelines and the timelines.
- November 2014** Bring first draft of scenarios/recommendations from the demographer to E&F
- December 2014** Gather feedback from E&F and determine modifications that need to be made prior to public meetings.
- February 2015** Begin feeder pattern meetings, webinars and town hall meetings at the five high schools to inform public of the issues we face and some of the possible solutions. These meetings will be guided by the E&F committee.
- February 2015** Contact principals of sites that may be impacted by boundary changes or closure.
- March 2015** Take information gathered from feeder pattern meetings and present it to E&F. Gather feedback from E&F.
- March-July 2015** Modify possible scenarios with the demographer based on the guidelines established by the Board of Education, the goals of the organization, feedback from the community and E&F.
- Sept/Oct 2015** Present final options at the five high schools to gather community feedback. Post the options on the internet and let the school communities provide additional input.
- Mid-Oct 2015** E&F approves boundary recommendations
- Late-Oct 2015** CAC Exec approves boundary recommendations
- November 2015** Boundaries presented to CAC General

Revised September 26, 2014

- December 2015** CAC General approves boundaries
- December 2015** The Superintendent reviews the CAC recommendations and either approves the recommendations or develops additional changes.
- January 2016** Present to the Board for approval the option that administration is recommending and E&F's recommendation if it is materially different than administrations, based on the needs/feedback of the community and the organization.
- January 2016** The Board of Education holds public hearings on the proposed modifications to the attendance boundaries and/or school closings. Following the public hearings, the Board may adopt changes to the attendance boundaries.
- February 2016** Begin communication to the school communities that will be affected by the changes.
