**Meeting called to order:** 7:04

**District Update:** (Pat Mogge) Karla Guzman will be assisting Patrick Mogge in the role of liaison to our group. Patrick will be assisting the Legislative Committee for CAC as well. The FACE survey is being disseminated across the district. Also, a communications audit is planned.

**Approval of Minutes:** The FACE meeting of last April was focused on review, edit and approval of the 2014 report to the Board of Education. As a result, meeting minutes were not required. Copies of that report were provided to the group., A brief overview of prior work and goals for this year were discussed.

**Group Work Session:**

Initial workgroups were determined. Transitions and engagement at the secondary levels was expanded to include the initiative to promote U-46 in a positive way. Changing perceptions in the community were discussed. The creation of a U-46 highlights brochure was discussed. A realtor breakfast for area professionals to discover the many positive programs within the district was discussed. PTO/PTA networking had a number of interested people to begin a audit/survey of contacts and support options that FACE might be able to bring about. Transformation schools developed a plan to discuss with administration what FACE might be able to do to foster engagement and address the Transformation Task Force recommendations, the inputs that FACE received from last year's principals roundtable discussions and the objectives that FACE identified as goals for this year.
