8	<p>Detective Andrew Houghton from the Elgin Police Dept. and Junaid Afeef from the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority presented the evening's program: Keeping Your Kids Safe in Cyberspace. The presentation was followed by a panel discussion featuring a high school student, middle school principal, social worker from the Social Emotional Response Team, and a School Resource Officer.</p> <p>Highlights: Advise your kids not to give out personal info to strangers online and to only friend or follow people that they actually know. Have reasonable expectations for your kids' online behavior: don't make the penalty for online misbehavior so bad that your kids are afraid to come to you when they need help. You should always have access to your kids' online accounts and be vigilant about 2nd secret accounts that are the profiles they actually use with friends. Steer your kids away from unknown, encrypted, or foreign-based apps. In Illinois, schools can investigate online activities that happen outside of school if it disrupts the educational environment.</p> <p>The PowerPoint of tonight's presentation can be found on the CAC website: www.u46cac.org/latest-updates/</p>
