	DESCRIPTION OF DISCUSSION
6	<p>Committee Updates:</p> <p>--Family and Community Engagement (FACE): Nov. 15 meeting topic is student-led conferences.</p> <p>--Curriculum Committee: Nov. 14 meeting will address the Workforce Readiness Law, CTE, and Dual Credit programs.</p> <p>--Specialized Student Services Committee: Committee meeting on Nov. 14 at 6:30 p.m. at the ESC will provide a preview of the committee's next 2 programs: Puberty and Your Special Needs Teen (Jan. 23) and Social Deficits (Feb. 27). 7	<p>Call for public comment: Diana Gunsteen noted a change in school culture at Bartlett Elementary School, as well as questions about school safety and recess procedures. She stated that parents feel their concerns are not being addressed by administration.</p>
8	<p>John Heiderscheidt (Director of School Safety and Culture) presented information about School Culture, Safety and Bullying.</p> <p>Discipline is meant to teach or mentor students, not to punish. There has been a paradigm shift from "What is wrong with this student?" to "what is this student going through?" The 5 Essentials survey results regarding school safety can be found online. The Student Code of Conduct is available on the District's website. The website also has an online reporting form for bullying. Board policy on bullying is a restorative approach rather than punitive. Heiderscheidt listed many protocols and procedures for school safety, including electronic access control and key fobs, panic buttons, lockdown locks, safety vests, 2-way radios, evacuation chairs for those with limited mobility, AEDs (defibrillators), classroom action plans, and the Raptor Visitor Management System.</p> <p>An Ad Hoc School Safety and Culture Committee is being formed to take a deeper look at the Student Code of Conduct and to allow members to be part of the vetting process for new safety procedures and equipment. Chairperson is Megan Larson. Meetings have been scheduled for January 8, February 21, and March 7 from 7-8 p.m. Location to be determined.
