

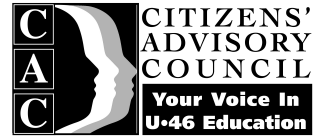

4	<p>Sue Kerr gave an update for the Board of Education.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> --Eastview, Larsen and Abbott Middle Schools are sending teams to compete at the Illinois Science Olympiad later this month at U of I in Champaign Urbana. --The Elgin High School Band was honored at the City of Elgin's Annual Image Awards last month. --Natalie Simons of Bartlett High School was named Health Educator of the Year by the IL School Health Association. --Elgin High School's Culinary Arts Team will be competing this month at the ProStart Invitational in Rhode Island. --Congratulations to the Larkin High School Boys Basketball Team on their trip to the State Final Four Tournament. --The Superintendent's Scholarship Program will award 30 scholarships this month to U-46 high school graduates who are the first in their families to pursue post-secondary education.
